Covenant

Adamic

Genesis 3:15

God would never again judge the world with a universal flood. The Messiah would be a descendant of Noah.

Noachian

Genesis 6:18; 9:8-17

An exalted descendant of David would be God's own Son, who would rule God's people forever.

Abrahamic

Genesis 12:1-3;
15:5-6; 17:19

The Messiah, a descendant of the woman, would remove the curse of sin.

Mosaic

Exodus 19:5-8; 34:10

God would bless the entire world through Abraham's descendants. The Messiah would be a descendant of Abraham.

Davidic

II Samuel 7:8-16

God provides personal salvation through the death of Christ. All who believe are born again.

New

Jeremiah 31:31-34;
Luke 22:20

God would reward His people with His care, prosperity, and victory over enemies if they obey the laws given through Moses. The moral laws reveal how the Messiah would live. The ceremonial laws reveal how He would pay the penalty of man's sins.
