

Cultural Geography Correction Items

Student Textbook

Chap. 1, Section Quiz, p. 8—Note that for question 6, the student will have to refer to a globe, world atlas, or world map to find the answers.

Chap. 1, Section Quiz, p. 12—Change question 7 to read “types of map projections” rather than “types of maps.”

Chap. 2, Section Quiz, p. 19—Change Bible reference to 2 Peter 3:5–13.

Chap. 3, Chapter Review, p. 76—The information for questions 2, 4, and 5 are not clearly mentioned in the student text. Feel free to skip these questions.

Chap. 4, Section Quiz, p. 87—Change question 4 to “the five *largest* religious groups.”

Chap. 4, Chapter Review, p. 99—Omit question 3 under “How Much Do You Remember?”

Chap. 14, Section Quiz, p. 377:

- Omit the word *Gambia* in question 2.

Chap. 17, p. 444—Add a negative sign (-) before the “92 feet” on the sixth line of the second paragraph of the section.

Chap. 18, pp. 460–61:

- Text should be revised to say of Tajikistan that “most of its people are *Sunni* Muslims,” *not Shiite* (1st printing only).
- Chapter Review, p. 465: Omit question 9.

Chap. 19:

- p. 487—Student text should be changed to read that Bangladesh “is considered *one of* the poorest” countries.
- Section Quiz, p. 492—Change question 1 to “Which European nation exerted the most influence over Sri Lanka?” (The answer is Great Britain.)

Teacher’s Edition

Chap. 3, Section Quiz, p. 62—Change answer to question 5 to “concrete.”

Chap. 3, Chapter Review, p. 76—Add note to answer for questions 4 and 5 to the effect that *some* but not *all* of the information to answer these questions is found in the chapter.

Chap. 10, Chapter Review, p. 261—Add a note for questions 2 and 5 under “How Much Do You Remember?” to the effect that the students might need to refer to pp. 212 and 215 of the Student Textbook for these answers.

Chap. 11, Section Quiz, p. 278—Add a note that the students will find the answer to question 3 in the preceding section of Chap. 11.

Chap. 14, Section Quiz, p. 377—Add a note that the students will find the answer to question 1 on pp. 353–54.

Chap. 18, Chapter Review, p. 465: Question 2(a) Tajikistan should be included in the answer for countries that are predominately Sunni.

Chap. 19, Section Quiz, p. 488—Add to the answer for question 4 under Pakistan “cotton, sugar cane, wheat, rice, milk, beef, mutton, and various fruits and vegetables.”

Student Activity Manual Answer Key

Chap. 2, Activity 4, p. 12—In question 1, change the word *transpiration* to *condensation*.

Chap. 4, Activity 1, p. 23:

- The answer to #5 (Middle East) is not in the 3rd edition student text.
- The answer to #6 (Asia) is not in the 3rd edition student text.
- The answer to #7 (Africa) is not in the 3rd edition student text.
- The answer to #8 (Five: Canada, Russia, United States, Australia, and New Zealand) is not in the 3rd edition student text.

Chap. 5, Activity 1, Map of Western Europe, p. 32:

- Rhine River is incorrectly labeled; it should be the next river to the southwest of where it is currently labeled.
- Paris is incorrectly labeled; it should be to the east on the Seine River.
- As labeled, Stockholm is a little too far inland; it should be located about 1/8 in. farther east.
- The Pennine Mountains are labeled too far north; they should be labeled a little farther south along the spine of northern England.

Chap. 5, Activity 4, Chapter Review, p. 37:

- The answer for question 3 could include Lichtenstein.
- The answer “River Thames” for question 17 as the longest river is incorrect. The River Severn is the longest in the United Kingdom.

Chap. 6, Activity 1, Map of Eastern Europe, p. 39:

- Montenegro and its capital are missing and should be included. (Refer to map on p. 141 of Student Textbook.)

- The Carpathian Mountains are incorrectly located; they should run from northern Slovakia in a curve to central Romania. (Refer to map on p. 141 of Student Textbook.)

Chap. 10, Activity 3, Chapter Review, pp. 79-81:

The answer for question 2, on page 80, under “The Midwest” should include Lake Superior, and the question should read, “The four Great Lakes. . . .”

Chapter 14, Activity 4, p. 111:

Question 12 should be changed to “West Africa’s smallest country.”

Chapter 16, Activity 3, pp. 125-26:

Yom Kippur is incorrectly listed as extrabiblical. The Bible refers to the day of the Atonement in passages such as Exodus 30:11 and Leviticus 16:29-30.

Chapter 19, Activity 5, p. 153:

Question 4’s answer should include Jumna River (see pp. 473-75), and the question should read, “What four rivers. . . .”

Chap. 21, Activity 3, p. 171—The answers given for items 4 and 5 are incorrect. The answer for item 4, “the busiest seaport in Southeast Asia,” should be Singapore (E), and the answer for item 5, “former Spanish colony that was controlled by the United States for almost fifty years,” should be Philippines (D)
