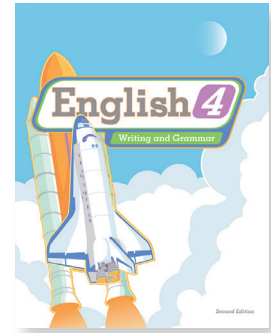

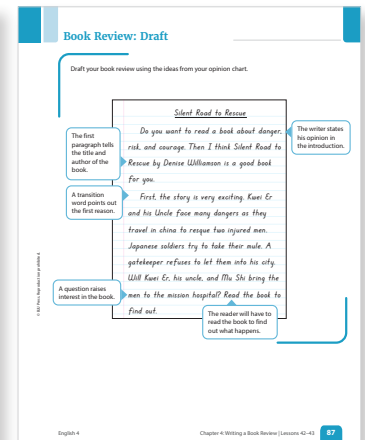
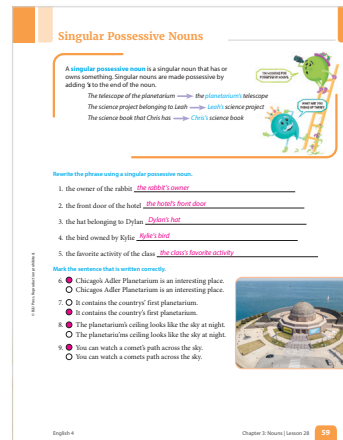

## Content Updates

- Chapter 2, “Personal Narrative,” was deleted and replaced with Chapter 7, “Writing a Story.”
- Chapter 4, “Writing a Friendly Letter,” and Chapter 14, “Writing a Business Letter” were deleted based on feedback.
- Instruction on prepositions was moved earlier to correct a scope-and-sequence scaffolding problem.
- The study and research chapter has been significantly updated.
- Number of lessons was increased from 165 to 180.
- The number of pages was increased from 384 to 392.
- The sequence of chapters and lessons was revised to better support the writing and grammar sequence.
- A teaching cycle was added to the teacher edition.
- New illustrations and photos in the worktext provide an engaging look and feel.
- Each chapter begins with a biblical worldview theme and instruction for developing a biblical worldview of language and communication.
