- meal, peal, seal*

Long vowel pattern: Open syllable
Miss Long alone at the end of a syllable
Examples:

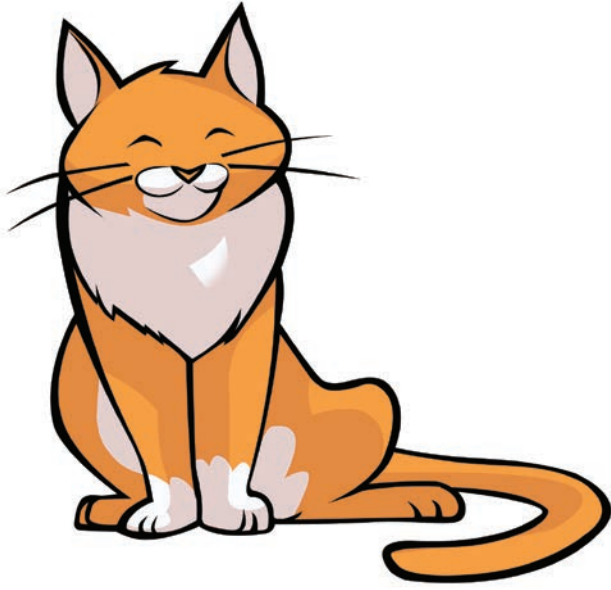
- he, me, she*
- no, no•ble*



Short vowel pattern: Closed syllable

(Pattern VCC)

Examples:

- back, pack, sack*
- sent, tent, went*



Alley Cat -ed



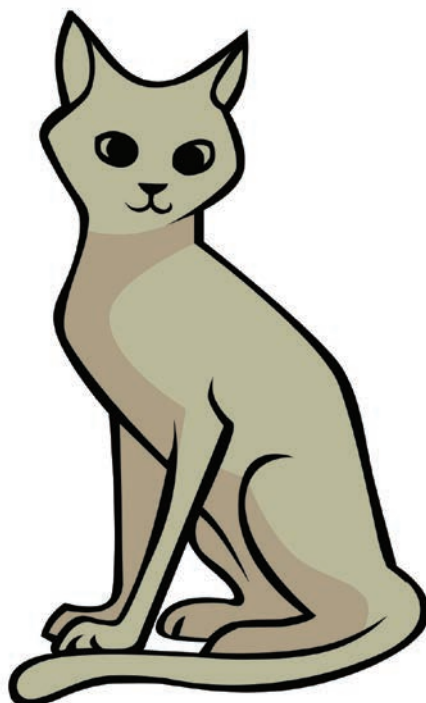
Alley Cat -er



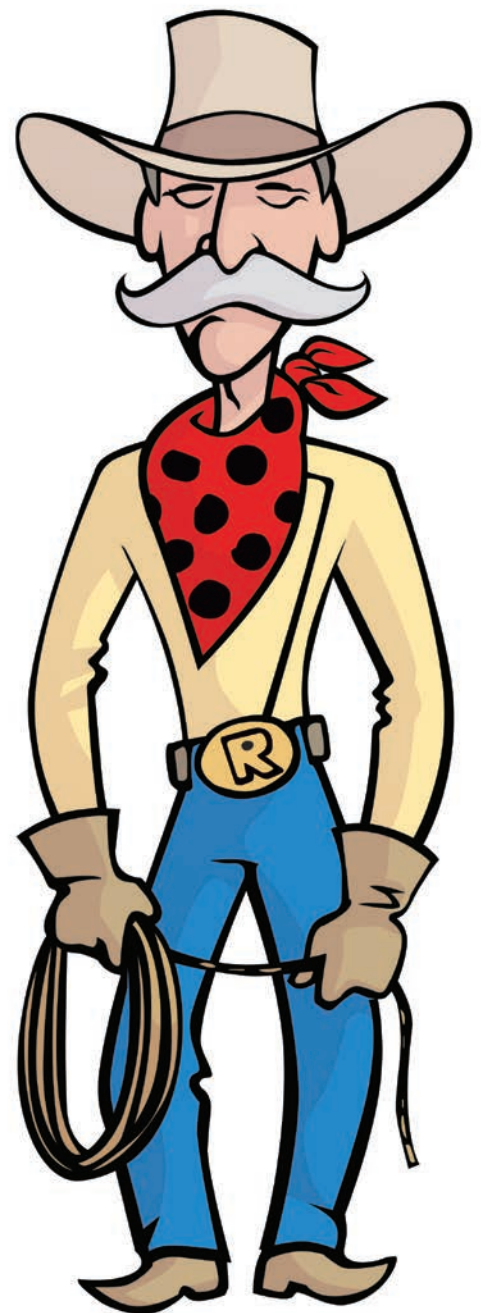
Marker e

Long vowel pattern: Silent e
Miss Long followed by
Marker e (Pattern VCe)

Examples:

bake, cake, lake

fine, line, pine
