

The PreCursive and Cursive fonts have been updated to be more compatible with modern programs. The fonts provided are OpenType fonts that can be downloaded and installed on Windows or MacOS computers. The following fonts are included in the download:


- Cursive-Regular
- Cursive-Arrows
- Cursive-Dashed
- PreCursive-Regular
- PreCursive-Arrows
- Pre-Cursive-Dashed

## Download and Install Fonts (Windows and MacOS)

### Install fonts for Windows

1. Download the font files.
2. Right-click on the .zip folder that is downloaded and then click Extract.
3. Open the new folder, where the font files are listed.
4. Right-click on the font file and click Install for each font.

### Install fonts for MacOS

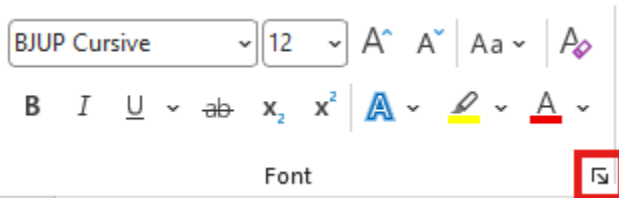
1. On your Mac, download the font files from Trove.
2. Do any of the following:
  - a. In the Font Book app  , choose File > Add Fonts to Current User. In the window that appears, double-click the font file.
  - b. Drag the font file to the Font Book app icon in the Dock, then click Install in the dialog that appears.
  - c. Drag the font file to the Font Book window.
  - d. Double-click the font file in the Finder, then click Install in the dialog that appears.

When you install a font, Font Book automatically *validates* (or checks) the font you're installing for errors. Font Book also checks for duplicate fonts.

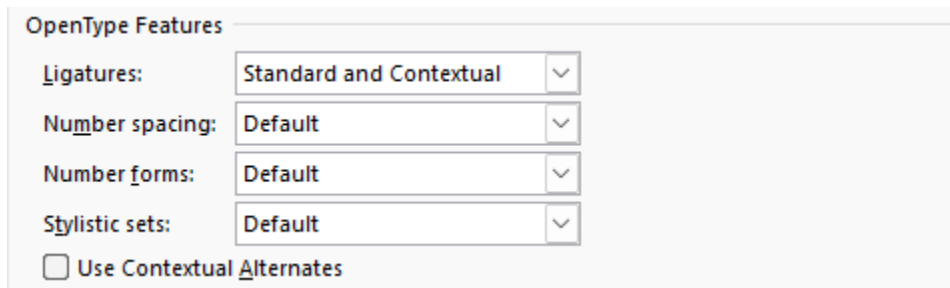
## Contextual Alternates

The Cursive fonts will use Contextual Alternates to automatically connect specific letters. Follow these steps to make sure Contextual Alternates are turned on in Microsoft Word:

1. Open the Fonts Menu



2. Click on the Advanced tab. Under OpenType Features, select Use Contextual Alternates.



Some programs like PowerPoint do not recognize the contextual alternates. We have provided a “helper” with the fonts that were downloaded that will open as a web page. You can input your text into this helper page.

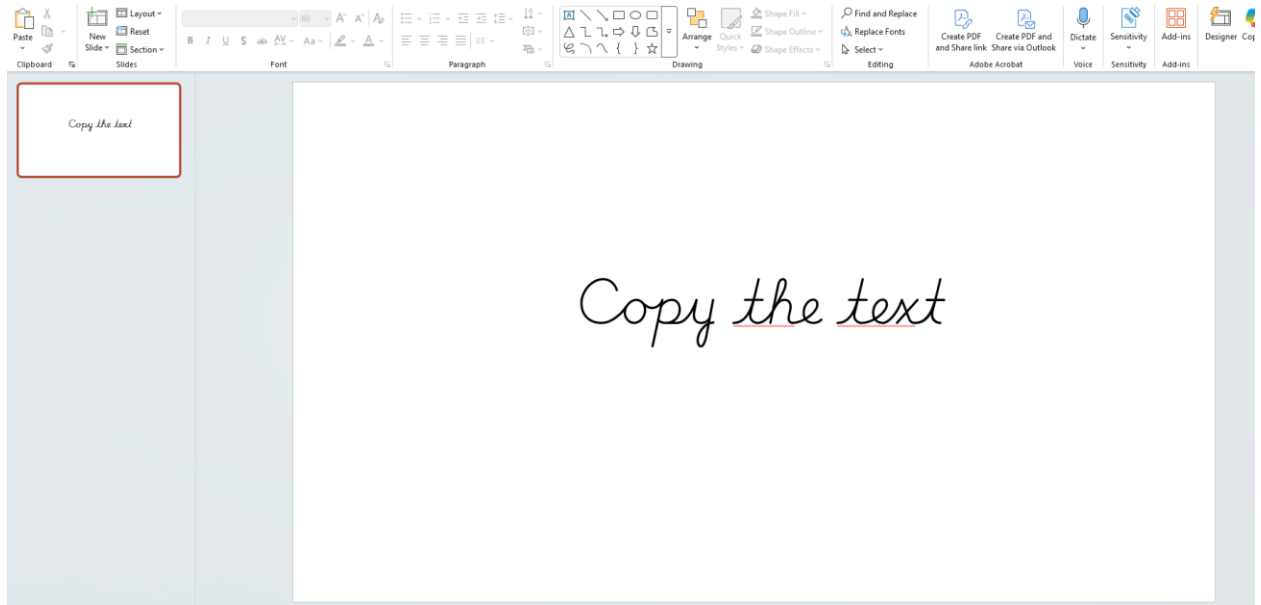

1. Type your text in the text field of the helper and click Copy.

2. In your program, such as PowerPoint, make sure the textbox has the BJUP Cursive font selected and then paste the text.



The text should copy and paste successfully. The webpage converts your text to a form that displays properly in PowerPoint. It does this by mixing 'private use' characters into the text, which often results in words that PowerPoint marks as misspelled. You can disable the red underlines by disabling the proofing if you choose.
